Greetings Guest Families,

Family and staff safety remain our top priority. We have been updated on the directives provided by Governor Whitmer and Michigan Department of Health and Human Services. We are doing everything we can to ensure we prevent the spread of COVID-19 within the Ronald McDonald House of Western Michigan. We would like to update you on how this will impact the families staying at the Ronald McDonald House. Effective Wednesday, November 18, 2020 the changes regarding Conditions of Stay are as follows:

1. Going back and forth from RMHWM to home is suspended until further notice. Travel is limited to and from the hospital.
2. Siblings are 2 per family. They must stay at the House as well and cannot go back and forth home. Only 6 kids total are allowed at the House at any given time.
3. No unapproved visitors, or other family members are allowed at the House at this time.
4. Family curfew time is 11:00 pm until 6:00 am.
5. Short term stays are suspended until further notice (7 days or less).

All families will continue to do their daily COVID-19 Wellness Assessment form and temperature checks through the front office.

We know this continues to be a challenging time for everyone. We will continue to provide you with any changes or updates as they become available.

We also understand that you may have questions and encourage you to stop by the front office.
